INTRODUCTION

MJRers use the term 'Spirit of Jesus moments' to describe the special kindnesses/acts of gratitude that occur around us everyday in our school communities, at home, during sporting events etc. We not only want to identify these moments but emulate them in our own lives.

Thus the saying 'Don't just see, but BE the Spirit of Jesus'.

LEARNING INTENTIONS

We are learning that...

- i) the Spirit of Jesus is so closely aligned to your heart
- ii) when we look and then reflect we will see that we are surrounded by 'Spirit of Jesus' (SOJ) moments
- iii) we will become a much better person if we look for and copy the SOJ moments that others constantly display
- iv) we need to do these everyday 24/7 not just at school.

- a) Write the numbers 1 to 10 acts of kindness with explanations on the whiteboard.
- b) Ask students to write the 1 to 10 acts in the reflection section of page 112.
- c) Ask students to vote for their favourite act of kindness and mark it on the board.
- d) Explore with students why those acts with the highest votes might have been chosen.


8.6 Pay it Forward Day

- 2. As a class, discuss what possible *pay it forward* moments students can suggest.

8.7 Create an Acts of Kindness Tree

- 1. At the beginning of the year, get students to paint a huge tree with bare branches and place on the wall in the classroom or corridor.
- Ask them to create several 'leaf' templates about the size of your palm – that can be written in. Print out the leaf templates on green paper (a variety of greens if possible) and cut out.
- 3. Invite students to take note of any acts of kindness, then write the name of the person enacting the kindness on to a leaf, and attach it to the painted tree. This is not limited to students performing acts of kindness, but anyone in their school community.
- 4. Toward the end of the year, organise a real tree to be planted in the school grounds in honour of this year's kindness tree.
- 5. You may also want to note the person whose name appears most on the tree and award them with an SOJ certificate.

SHARING RESOURCES

Why not print out the following postcards – on a half A4 page or cardboard sheet, and either:

- a) fill in one for a staff colleague
- b) share with other staff to use with colleagues or leave on someone's desk without signing your name.
